5. The problem involves the wiring of the safety belt tensioners. Specifically, a crimp connector of the belt tensioner wiring is not in accordance with specifications. As a result, sufficient contact between the wiring and a plug connection may not occur. This could lead to an increase in the electrical resistance of that connection. If that happened, it would be possible for the belt tensioner not to deploy. However, in such a case, the warning lamp in the instrument cluster would illuminate.
