Dear Ms/Mrs Kelly Schuler,

This letter is submitted by the Sprinter Engineering and Compliance Support Team, a division of Mercedes-Benz USA, LLC, on behalf of our parent company, Daimler AG, to inform you that although Daimler, AG submitted the 573 report for a safety defect in our intake manifold of approximately 13,509 Sprinter vans MY 2002 and 2003 on October 16, 2009, we will launch the campaign and provide a copy of the owner letters in approximately 3 weeks from today.

Chrysler Group, LLC will conduct a voluntary recall campaign for the subject Sprinter vehicles described above. On the subject vehicles the intake manifold will be replaced.

There will be no charge to owners of the subject vehicles. Owners who incurred costs to obtain a remedy for the problem addressed by the recall prior to the recall will be reimbursed.

Chrysler Group, LLC will submit the owner notification letters when they are made available.
