Re: Safety Defect Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On December 9, 2009, Fleetwood RV, Inc. decided that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on December 11, 2009.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 91209FRV as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood RV, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are certain 2010 model year Jamboree Sport and Tioga Ranger Model 25G Class C motor homes manufactured from April 20, 2009 through December 7, 2009.

The December 7, 2009 date coincides with the introduction of a process to route the LPG supply line away from possible contact with the chassis spring assembly.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of:
788GA4701563 through 788GA4701840
789GA4701473 through 789GA4701844
789GA4404448 through 789GA4404636
788GA4404637

- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 60 as the number of model year 2010 Jamboree Sport and Tioga Ranger 25G model motor homes that contain the safety defect.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the affected model year 2010 Jamboree Sport and Tioga Ranger 25G Class C model motor homes contain the safety defect.
- (5) On certain model year 2010 Jamboree Sport and Tioga Ranger 25G model motor homes, the LPG supply line routed through the rear wheel well may come in contact with the chassis spring assembly causing damage to the LPG supply line.

The damaged LPG supply line may result in a propane gas leak and could result in a fire.

- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in December 2009 after a Fleetwood customer reported the LPG supply line was found to be damaged while the unit was being evaluated for a significant loss of propane by a non-Fleetwood dealer.

Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this safety defect.

- (8) Fleetwood dealers will inspect the routing of the LPG supply line and reroute its location.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail on TBD.


Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification on TBD.

 - III) Service Bulletin
