Dear Mr. Smith:

The following information is an update of the 573.6(c)(10) information in our December 18, 2009 letter as it relates to a decision by General Motors to recall certain 2005-2007 model year Chevrolet Corvette and 2006-2007 model year Chevrolet Corvette Z06 vehicles for a condition in which the adhesive between the roof panel and the frame may separate. This information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6.

GM is amending its December 18, 2009 letter to change the original mail date of owner letters and dealer bulletins from January 2010 to April 2010. The revised date is due to the availability of the headliner (base model) and bolts (Z06 model). Details of the field remedy content became available after the submission of GM's letter and thus the revised mailing date.

573.6(c)(10): GM will provide the dealer bulletin and owner letter when available. GM anticipates that the dealer bulletin and owner letters will be sent in April 2010.
