Safety Recall Notification

To: All Starcraft Dealers

Subject: Pre-Notification of Recall

This letter is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Starcraft, in cooperation with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, is announcing a recall, which relates to vehicle safety in specific Model Year 2009 Starcraft Lexion series 34IKTS and 36RLTS fifth-wheels manufactured between August 18, 2008 and October 20, 2008.

Starcraft has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in specific model year Model Year 2009 Starcraft Lexion series 34IKTS and 36RLTS fifth-wheels. There may be a missing ground wire between the trailer frame and the 12-volt bus bar. This condition, if not addressed, could result in a fire, injury or death.

Starcraft is contacting all dealers and retail customers for notification of the recall. The final repair instructions should be available within the next 5 working days.

If you have one of these models in your inventory, NHTSA Federal Guidelines state: *"A dealer is prohibited from selling to the public any new motor vehicle or item of motor vehicle equipment, which might contain a safety-related defect, until the defect is remedied."*

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Starcraft RV, Inc. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in specific Model Year 2009 Starcraft Lexion series 32RLTS, 34IKTS and 36RLTS fifth-wheels manufactured between June 23, 2008 and October 20, 2008.

Starcraft has identified that there may be a missing ground wire between the trailer frame and the 12-volt bus bar. If this condition is not addressed, it may result in a fire, injury, or death.

The remedy includes installation of the appropriate ground wire. If you have had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information or if you are unable to have this repair performed, please contact Starcraft Customer Service at 1-800-945-4787 for assistance.

Please contact your Starcraft dealer, who is best equipped to perform this repair. If your Starcraft dealer is unable to perform the recall within a reasonable time frame, please contact Starcraft Customer Service for further instructions. Any non-Starcraft dealer must contact Starcraft prior to making the recall repairs for proper authorization and instruction. If you have sold or traded your vehicle, or for any reason cannot have this recall service performed, please let us know by completing the information on the enclosed post card and returning it

to us promptly. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within **ten days**.

If, however, you take your recreational vehicle to your dealer on the agreed service date and the dealer does not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, please contact our Customer Service department at 1-800-945-4787. After contacting your Starcraft dealer and Starcraft Customer Service and you are not able to have the safety defect remedied without charge and/or within a reasonable time, you may wish to submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.

We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we have taken this action in the interest of your safety and continued satisfaction with your Starcraft recreational vehicle.
