


- Open rear glass
- Slide trim removal wedge 3409 or equivalent between hinged window trim -2- and the cover -1-
- Slide trim removal wedge through tape -3- in direction of arrow -a- to detach trim from vehicle
- Remove cover -1- by pulling down in direction of arrows -b-
- Discard trim piece



Tip: Excess tape must be removed from rear hinged window to allow for proper seating of new trim cover during installation







Carefully lift spoiler off hinged window and disconnect brake lamp connector -circle-








