Dear Ms. Sorg:

This letter responds to the U.S. Department of Transportation's ("Dot") letter dated May 7, 2012.

As stated in our April 2, 2012 letter, we intended to submit a new Part 573 Report to NHTSA on or before April 30, 2012. Our submission was delayed; however we submitted it on May 7, 2012. A copy of our submission is attached hereto for your reference.

Furthermore, as stated in our April 2, 2012 letter, we intended to send a repaired MY 2008 ZAP Xebra to Karco Engineering ("Karco") no later than April 30, 2012 for retesting and certification. We were delayed in delivering the repaired MY 2008 ZAP Xebra as a result of additional work required when we discovered that the batteries in the vehicle needed to be conditioned. The vehicle's mileage was only 11 miles per charge. Since one of the required tests that Karco will be conducting on the vehicle entails driving the vehicle 250 to 300 miles to retest the stopping distance, and this would have taken a long period of time to complete at 11 miles per charge, we opted to drive the vehicle in order to increase the speed and distance the car is able to achieve per charge. As of today, we have increased the mileage to 17 miles per charge. We have made arrangements to ship the vehicle on Tuesday, May 15, 2012 to Karco and it will be

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received at Karco on or about Wednesday May 16, 2012. Karco has advised us that they will begin testing the vehicle promptly on the date of its arrival.

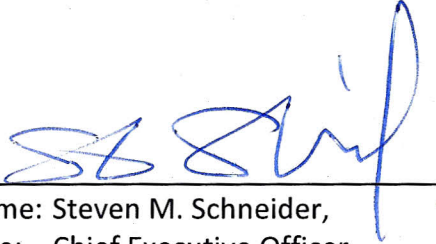
We hope this response fully addresses the DOT's concerns. Please do not hesitate to contact our counsel should you have additional questions or concerns.
