In our acknowledgment of this safety recall of June 5, 2009, we specifically reminded you of the company's obligation under Federal law to file six quarterly status reports on the recall, and provided you a schedule for doing so. A copy of this letter is enclosed


On January 8, 2010, you were sent a letter from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration concerning a missing quarterly report for safety recall campaign 09E-025 for the third 2009. A copy of the notice is enclosed. You were also instructed to reply to this office no later than January 26, 2010. You did not respond.

This is your third, and last, reminder of your company's deficiency pursuant to Federal law.

This letter is being sent to your company pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 30166, which authorizes NHTSA to conduct any investigation that may be necessary to enforce Chapter 301 of Title 49. Your company's failure to respond promptly and fully to this letter could subject your company to civil penalties pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 30165 or lead to an action for injunctive relief pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 30163. If your company does not respond immediately with the required information, we will have no choice but to consider appropriate enforcement action to include, but not limited to, an action for injunctive relief and/or civil penalties. Manufacturers that fail to meet their statutorily prescribed obligations pertaining to safety recalls, including failures to provide required reports, may be penalized up to \$6,000 per violation, with a maximum of \$16,375,000 for a related series of violations. See 49 U.S.C. § 30165 and 49 CFR 578.6.
