Please find enclosed the remaining two quarterly campaign reports as promised in our April 29, 2011 letter, as required by 49 CFR 573.7 of the defect reporting regulations, for the calendar quarter ending March 31, 2011:

This is our sixth quarterly report to submit for 09E-063. In the 5 previous quarterly reports, the manner in which we were calculating the number of repaired vehicles included vehicles that were inspected but no repair was necessary (or in this case vehicles that did not have an affected nose mask installed). This sixth quarterly report reflects the correct number of vehicles that had the affected nose mask replaced (or repaired) out of approximately 3,700 nose masks that were sold at a completion rate of 42%. In addition to initial first class mail notification, we have sent follow-up notification by mail to all owners. Please advise if you require additional quarterly reports.
