**IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 09V-098
April 2009**

**Pacific Coachworks, Inc. Model year 2008 276RBS and 299BHS
travel trailer tire pressure decals applied between
April 26, 2007 and December 18, 2008**

Dear Valued Tango Customers:

WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE: This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Pacific Coachworks, Inc., located in Riverside, California has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2008 model year travel trailers.

Pacific Coachworks has discovered incorrect tire pressure decals on some of our 276RBS and 299BHS travel trailers.

Incorrect tire pressure decals can lead to improper tire inflation which could result in a tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Due to safety related reasons please adhere to the manufacturers tire pressure specifications. Please make certain you immediately inspect your decal to confirm if it is correct or incorrect.

We have enclosed a new correct tire pressure decal in case an incorrect decal needs to be replaced. (See attachment 1)

If you sold the travel trailer or traded it in, please take a moment to provide the name and address of the person or dealership you sold it to on the bottom of the enclosed response card and return it to Pacific Coachworks. This will allow us to update our records and if necessary, notify the new owner using the information provided.

For leased vehicles - Any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Please locate your 2008 Tango Model **276RBS** or **299BHS** below.

The tire pressure decal is located at the front of your unit on the roadside.

If you have the incorrect tire pressure on your decal it matches the specifications on figure 1, under your specific model. If the specifications are correct they match figure 2 under your model.

What you should do if you have the:

Incorrect decal:

Clean the incorrect decal with soap and water and let dry. Take the correct decal we have provided and place over the incorrect decal. Complete the response card and send it back to Pacific Coachworks as soon as possible.

If you are uncomfortable putting the new decal on you can take to a Tango dealer and have the dealer put the decal on, at no cost to you.

Correct decal: Complete the response card and send it back to Pacific Coachworks.
