Dear Tiffin Motorhome Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and the Canadian Motor Vehicles Safety Act.

It has been determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists on some Allegro Bus Models with PowerGlide chassis manufactured from May 1, 2007 through April 14, 2009.

The rear axle ABS modulating valves may be wired incorrectly. The left and right modulator valve harnesses may have been reversed. Under slippery road conditions, when in the ABS mode, this may cause one side of the rear axle wheels to lock, while causing little or no braking effort on the opposite side. This may result in a vehicle crash without warning.

The inspection/modification consists of inspecting the rear axle ABS modulating valve harness pins for correct orientation in the connector and re-orientation if necessary.

You should contact the nearest Cummins Coach Care facility as soon as possible to arrange to have your vehicle inspected/modified. If there is not a Cummins Coach Care facility near by, you can contact Tiffin Motorhomes at (256) 356-8661 and ask for the Chassis Plant. We will locate a facility to perform the work. When contacting the service facility, reference campaign number 09V-127. Please allow approximately 1.0 hours to have this modification completed. This modification will be performed at no charge to you.

IMPORTANT: When the modification has been completed on your vehicle, please ensure that a sticker has been affixed to the front of the ABS ECU, referencing 09V-127.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Tiffin Warranty Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner

If your vehicle is involved in the Canadian portion, you may notify the Manager, Recall and Public Compliance, Road and Motor Vehicle Traffic Safety Branch, Transport Canada, Ottawa, Ontario, or phone (613) 993-9851.
