Non-Compliance Recall – Update to Load Carrying Capacity Modification (Addendum) Label

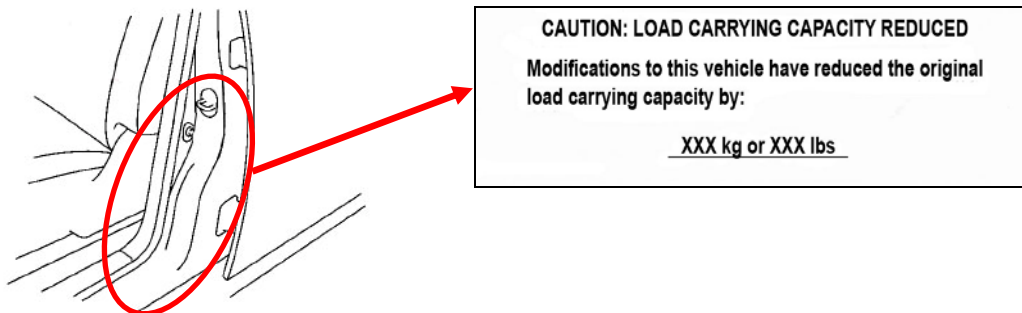
Dear Scion Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Scion has decided that your vehicle (VIN listed above) fails to conform to a provision of the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) as it relates to Load Carrying Capacity Modification (Addendum) Labels.

What is the condition?

The Addendum Label is a yellow label (see diagram below) located on the driver's side center pillar. The label provides the weight of Scion Genuine Accessories added to your vehicle which was not already taken into account in the vehicle occupant and cargo carrying capacity located on the Tire and Loading Information Label.

In the majority of affected vehicles, the current Addendum Label is not correct in that it overstates the weight of Scion Genuine Accessories installed on the vehicle at one of our Vehicle Processing Centers. In addition, on a small number of vehicles the required Addendum Label was not installed at all. In the worst case, a driver may overload a vehicle which may increase the risk of a crash.



What will Scion do?

Enclosed, you will find a new Addendum Label for your specific vehicle (VIN listed above). Please note that, if on your vehicle, the weight of Scion Genuine accessories was already factored into the occupant and cargo carrying capacity before the accessories were installed, the corrected Addendum Label will reflect that the load carrying capacity was reduced by "0 kg or 0 lbs". In this case, you may rely on the Vehicle Capacity Weight stated on the Tire and Loading Information Placard on the driver's side door jamb, near the Addendum Label.

What should you do?

Please assist us by affixing the enclosed Addendum Label to your vehicle. Installation instructions are located on the following page.

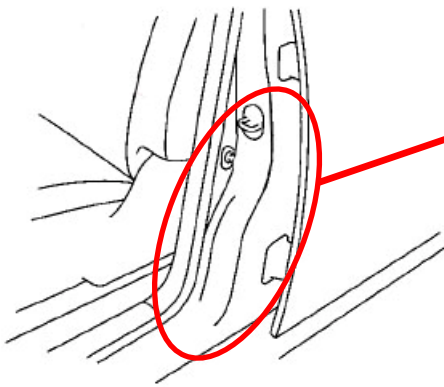

Addendum Label Installation Instructions

I. Affected Vehicles that currently have an Addendum Label

1. Locate the Addendum Label currently installed on your vehicle, see illustrations below.

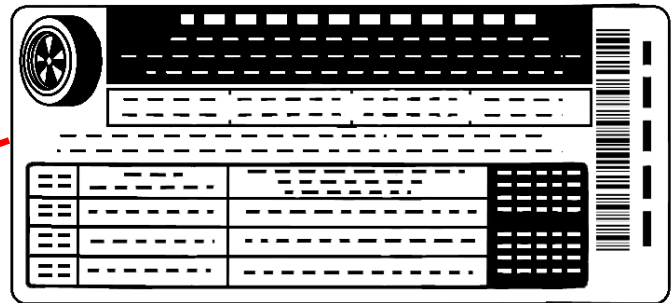
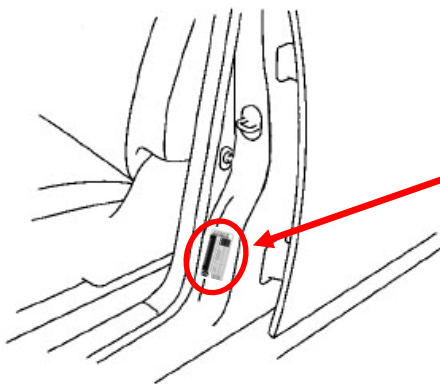

2. Clean the Addendum Label currently installed on your vehicle and the surrounding areas with a clean, dry cloth to remove any dust or dirt.
3. Affix the new Addendum Label on top of the current label installed on your vehicle.

II. Affected Vehicles that currently DO NOT have an Addendum Label

1. Locate the Tire and Loading Information Placard currently installed on your vehicle, see illustrations below.



Locate this Placard to position the Addendum Label

Tire and Loading Information Placard Location (may vary by model)

2. Locate an area on the driver door post that meets the following criteria:
 - Large enough for the Addendum Label to be installed without overlapping any other labels.
 - As close to the Tire and Loading Information Placard as possible.
3. Clean the area located in the previous step with a clean dry cloth. Make sure to clean an area slightly larger than the Addendum Label.
4. Affix the new Addendum Label to the area located above.
