- RECALL NOTICE -

**Subject: Hydraulic Brake Line Routing
Glaval # ???-???- Daimler # 09V-114**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic And Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Dear Glaval Bus Customer,

Glaval Bus in conjunction with Daimler Trucks North America LLC has decided a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain Freightliner FB-65 (Glaval model "Concorde") model year 2005.

Notice: Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten (10) days.

WHAT IS BEING RECALLED:

This recall process applies to FB-65 model year 2005. Hydraulic brake line routing may cause contact with the transmission dipstick tube as the engine rocks.

WHY IS IT BEING RECALLED:

Continued contact between the brake lines and the transmission dipstick tube could lead to a loss of brake fluid and reduced brake performance, potentially resulting in a vehicle crash without warning.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

Contact your authorized dealer to arrange to have your vehicle(s) modified and to assure that parts are available at the dealer. When you contact your dealer, refer to campaign number **FL-550**. To locate a dealer, search online at www.FreightlinerTrucks.com, www.SterlingTrucks.com, or contact the Warranty Campaigns Department at (800) 547-0712, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Pacific Time, Monday through Friday for assistance. After normal business hours you may contact Customer Assistance Center at (800) FTL-HELP or (800) STL-HELP. **IMPORTANT:** When the recall has been completed, please ensure that a label has been affixed to your vehicle referencing **FL-550**.

WHAT THE DAIMLER TRUCKS NORTH AMERICA LLC WILL DO:

Potentially affected units will be inspected. Improperly routed brake lines will be rerouted, and any damaged brake lines will be replaced.

Reimbursement Plan: Copies will be submitted as a supplemental report when available.

If after contacting the authorized dealer and Daimler Trucks North America LLC Warranty Campaigns Department or Customer Assistance Center and your inspection and/or repair is not completed in a reasonable time, which is not longer than 60 days after you tender the vehicle for repair, or without charge you may notify:
