Dear Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Our records indicate that you have purchased a vehicle with the serial number which appears above.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Winnebago Industries, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain 2007 and 2008 Model Year Winnebago® (Models: Access®, Aspect®, Sightseer®, and Vista®); 2007 and 2008 Model Year Itasca® (Models: Impulse®, Cambria®, Sunova®, and Sunstar®); 2009 and 2010 Model Year Winnebago (Models: Access, Sightseer, and Vista); and 2009 and 2010 Model Year Itasca (Models: Impulse, Sunova, and Sunstar).

These motor homes were manufactured January 25, 2007 through July 17, 2009. These vehicles may have a missing stove partition that isolates the furnace return air. If the furnace is operated at the same time as the stove and the partition is missing, the stove flame may go out and the propane gas will continue to flow, which has the potential to ignite resulting in personal injury and/or vehicle and property damage.

WHAT WE WILL DO

Winnebago Industries, Inc. dealers will correct this situation by installing a stove partition that isolates the stove from the furnace return air at no charge to you.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Please contact your Winnebago Industries, Inc. dealer immediately to arrange for an appointment. Please allow sufficient time for your dealer to obtain the kit for this recall. The labor time necessary to perform this correction will be approximately one hour. Please allow additional time for the dealer to process your vehicle.

Winnebago Industries, Inc. dealers are best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your vehicle is corrected as promptly as possible. HOWEVER, if you take your vehicle to the dealer on the agreed date and he does not service this condition on that date or within five days, we recommend you contact Winnebago Industries, Inc., Attn.: Owner Relations Representative (641-585-6939).
