This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Trans Tech Bus (Trans Tech) has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists on certain vehicles it manufactured between June 1 2008 and October 19, 2009. The units affected by this recall are single or dual rear wheel School buses and multi function School buses with a GVWR of 10,000 pounds or under.

What the safety concern is:

The non-compliance involves Federal Motor Vehicle Safety standard No. 110. *Tire Selection and Rims*. Vehicles that are not affixed with the proper Tire and load decal, lacks the proper information needed to select the appropriate tires and payload limitations. With out this information, it would be possible to overload the vehicle, which could affect vehicle handling and occupant or pedestrian safety.

What Trans Tech Bus will do?

Trans Tech Bus or your Dealer will provide the proper information and decal to you at no cost.

Address or ownership change:

Please notify us of any change in vehicle ownership or if you have changed your address.

What we are requesting you do:

To inspect your vehicle for the proper Tire and Loading information decal located at the Driver's door B pillar. In the event that the decal is missing, please install the decal provided in this packet.

Call your dealer immediately. Ask for a service date for Safety recall #**09V-416**

If you have already paid for this repair:

If you paid to have this service done before the date of this letter, please contact your Trans Tech Bus for reimbursement. Please refer to the enclosed letter for recall service and contact information.

How long will repairs take?

The time needed to correct this defect is less than 5minutes.
