Kongsberg (KPPS) Adjustable Brake Pedals

January 6, 2010

Dear Tiffin Motorhome Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Tiffin Motorhomes, Inc. has decided that a defect exists in certain 2008 through 2010 Allegro Bus Models with PowerGlide chassis manufactured from May 1, 2007 through December 31, 2009.

The drive pin which secures the brake pedal arm to the remainder of the assembly may become disengaged, resulting in a loss of vehicle braking function and / or causing the brake pedal to move out of position and interfere with the throttle pedal function. Either condition could result in a vehicle crash.

The modification consists of installing a C-clamp fixture on the brake pedal arm to secure the pin in position. The C-clamp kit and instructions have been sent to you along with this letter. Please carry these instructions and the C-clamp kit with you when taking your vehicle in for this repair.

You should contact the nearest Tiffin Service Dealer, or the nearest Cummins Coach Care facility as soon as possible to arrange to have your vehicle modified. If there is not a repair facility near by, you can contact Tiffin Motorhomes at (256) 356-8661 and ask for the Chassis Plant. We will locate a facility to perform the work. When contacting the service facility, reference campaign number 09V-496. Please allow approximately .5 hours to have this modification completed. This modification will be performed at no charge to you.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
