Dear Foretravel Owner:

This Notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Reason for this Recall: Foretravel, Inc. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists on certain 2008 through 2010 year model Foretravel Nimbus and Phenix Series Motorhomes equipped with an adjustable brake pedal assembly supplied by Kongsberg Power Products Systems.

There have been no reports of any failures related to the specific part number assembly used as a component on Foretravel coaches, nevertheless there exists the possibility that these particular assemblies may contain a drive pin that can become disengaged, resulting in a loss of vehicle braking function and/or causing the brake pedal to move out of position and interfere with the throttle function. Either condition could result in a vehicle crash.

What We Will Do: Foretravel, Inc. will repair all of the affected assemblies which can include installation of a secondary drive pin retention mechanism (C-clamp). This remedy will be made at no cost to you.

What You Should Do: Your Authorized Foretravel service dealer is best equipped to provide this service and to insure that the recall is addressed as promptly as possible. The labor time for the remedy will take less than one (1) hour. Additional time may be necessary, depending on how the service facility appointments are scheduled and parts availability.
