

CHROMIUM-PLATED DOOR INSIDE HANDLE REPAIR

1. DESCRIPTION

Subject

This bulletin provides the procedure for repairing SONATA (EF) door inside handle whose outer chromium plating may peel off.



2. APPLICABLE VEHICLES

- Model: SONATA (EF)
- Applicable vehicle production date range: From Jan. 28, 2002 to Mar. 22, 2003
- Applicable VIN range: Use "JWalk" Screen to verify applicable VIN.
- Area: Puerto Rico

5. SERVICE PROCEDURE


- Check if part of a chromium-plated door inside handle has already peeled off on an affected vehicle. (Carry out the visual inspection on all 4 doors.)
 - If yes, replace it with new one with reference to a SONATA (EF) shop manual.
 - If not, cover it with the protection wrap according to the below procedure.




2. Peel the protection wrap off the backing.



3. Cover the door inside handle with the protection wrap.




4. Stretch the protection wrap tight in the arrow direction on the front side of the inside handle.



5. Stretch the protection wrap tight in the arrow direction on the upper side of the inside handle.



6. Turn back the upper edge of the protection wrap toward the back of the door inside handle, then stretch it tight.



7. Check if the protection wrap is properly attached on the door inside handle, then rub it gently and evenly again.
