

Safety Recall Notice



If you had purchased or own a Long Chih single axle trailer manufactured between September 1st, 2005 to December 31st, 2008, these trailers are missing the tire placard label which states the tire size, tire pressure, and maximum load information. The gross vehicle weight rate (GVWR) on the VIN plate on some of the trailers is incorrect and the GVWR and gross axle weight rate (GAWR) units should be specified in pounds on the VIN plate. A misprinted label could lead to improper vehicle loading specification or tire inflation which could result in a tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.
