Summary:
STARCRAFT IS RECALLING CERTAIN MODEL YEAR 2010 CENTENNIAL CAMPING TRAILERS MANUFACTURED FROM NOVEMBER 11, 2009 THROUGH APRIL 6, 2010. THE AXLE IS LOCATED TOO FAR FORWARD ALLOWING THE TIRES TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE WHEEL WELL, WHICH MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE TIRE AND/OR THE WHEEL WELL.

Consequence:
IF THIS CONDITION IS NOT REPAIRED, IT MAY RESULT IN A CRASH, POSSIBLY CAUSING INJURY OR DEATH.

Remedy:

STARCRAFT WILL NOTIFY OWNERS AND DEALERS WILL REPAIR THE VEHICLES FREE OF CHARGE. THE SAFETY RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING AUGUST 2010. OWNERS MAY CONTACT STARCRAFT AT 1-800-945-4787.

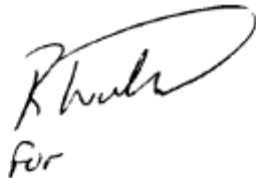
The information in your defect report appears to satisfy the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6.

You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter in which the campaign was initiated. Thereafter, quarterly reports will be due on or before 30 days after close of the calendar quarter.
