Montana Ventures, LLC d/b/a Marathon Seat Covers ("Marathon") hereby submits the following amendment to its PART 573 Defect and Noncompliance Report originally submitted September 2, 1010. The following amended Part 6 should replace the corresponding portion of Marathon's original report in its entirety.

6. With respect to a defect, furnish a chronological summary (including dates) of all the principle events that were the basis for the determination of the defect. The summary should include, but not be limited to, the number of reports, accidents, injuries, fatalities, and warranty claims.

On August 24, 2010, a new customer calling about seat covers for a Chevrolet Suburban asked about a tag on the seats that indicated the presence of a side airbag. The salesperson passed the call to our head of production. Our head of product immediately made calls to the local dealer to confirm this, and discovered that the manufacturer had not changed the seat design but had added side airbags to this vehicle model. Our head of product immediately began researching all vehicle models for which we have manufactured seat covers, to determine if there were any other vehicle manufacturers who may have added side airbags without changing the seat design. While this process was going, we contacted counsel on August 25, 2010 to seek advice about compliance with any applicable laws or regulations. By August 30, 2010, we had compiled a list of all of the seat cover patterns that were affected. We have also implemented new procedures to ensure that we determine with all new orders whether the vehicle has side airbags. Other than the new customer on August 24th who mentioned the presence of side airbags in the Chevrolet Suburban, no other customer has referred to this issue. We have received no complaints, warranty claims, or reports of any accidents, injuries, fatalities or failure of any airbags to properly deploy.
