Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Jayco, Inc. (“Jayco” or the “Company”) is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.6(c)(2)

Affected vehicles were manufactured between October 14, 2009 and January 15, 2010.

Model Year 2010 Jayco Insignia Motorhomes series 36CKFL and 40FKSA.

Jayco, Inc., the responsible manufacturer, determined the recall population from its manufacturing records.

573.6(c)(3)

A total of two - (2) Jayco motorhomes are subject to this recall.
Specific Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN) are as follows:

- 2010 Insignia Motorhomes with a starting VIN of 4UZAB2BS2ACAR9024 and ending with 4UZAB2BS6ACAP7950.

Both units are on dealer lots and have not been retail sold.

573.6(c)(4)

Jayco is recalling 100 percent of the affected models of Jayco motorhomes identified in the scope.

573.6(c)(5)

The affected units were built using chassis manufactured by Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation and which are affected by their recall 09V-461. The Kongsberg Power Products Systems (KPPS) adjustable brake pedals may loosen. The drive pin which secures the brake pedal arm to the balance assembly may become disengaged, this may cause a reduction in vehicle braking and/or cause the brake pedal to move out of position and interfere with throttle

pedal function. A reduction in braking or interference with the throttle pedal could result in a crash.

573.6(c)(6)

Jayco decided to conduct this recall following notification from Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation. Jayco is not aware of any injuries or accidents related to this issue.

573.6(c)(8)

The remedy for the affected motorhomes is to install a clamp assembly on the adjustable brake pedal arm, preventing it from loosening.

Since all units are in Dealer stock and none have been retail-sold, only Dealer notification letters will be provided to the agency within 10 business days. Upon notification Jayco is prepared to begin dealer notification within 5 business days after approval.
