Dear Mr. Smith:

General Coach is providing an update to the Defect and Non-Compliance report that it submitted on February 5, 2010. NHTSA acknowledged the report and assigned recall number 10V-062. General Coach is amending the following sections of its report:

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The recall population includes the following buses manufactured by General Coach.

<u>Models</u>	<u>Model Years</u>
Lo-Trans	2005 - 2006
EZ-Trans	2007
IC – LC	2009 – 2010

These buses were manufactured by General Coach from July 2003 until February 2010. These buses were built on International 3200IM chassis.

The total number of buses subject to this recall campaign is 66. Approximately 90 percent of the vehicles contain the defect.

- D. Remedying of Defect. General Coach worked cooperatively with International to define the remedy for this defect. If found to contain the defect, the buses will be retrofitted with an aftermarket transmission retarder that will lower the temperatures of the braking components down into the normal operating range. The owners of the buses subject to this recall campaign will be advised to contact General Coach. The remedy will be done at no charge to the owners of the bus.

The remedy of the affected buses started May 10, 2010 and will continue at a rate of 4 to 5 per week until all buses are remedied.

- F. Owner Notifications. Attached is an owner's letter for approval.
- G. Dealer Notification. Attached is a dealer's letter for approval.
