Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Entegra Coach ("Entegra" or the "Company") is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.6(c)(2)

Affected vehicles were manufactured between March 24, 2009 and February 16, 2010.

Model Year 2009 & 2010 Entegra Anthem Motorhome series 42RB, 44SL, and 42DL.
Model Year 2010 Entegra Cornerstone Motorhome series 45DL and 46RB.

Entegra Coach, the responsible manufacturer, determined the recall population from a list of VINs provided by Spartan Chassis.

573.6(c)(3)

A total of eighteen - (18) Entegra motorhomes are subject to this recall.
Specific Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN) are as follows:

- Sixteen (16) - 2009 & 2010 Anthem Motorhomes with a starting VIN of 4VZBT1D909C068680 ending with 4VZBT1D999C066667.
- Two (2) - 2010 Cornerstone Motorhomes with a starting VIN of 4VZAU1C92AC072003 ending with 4VZAU1C95AC071458.

573.6(c)(4)

Entegra is recalling 100 percent of the affected models of Entegra motorhomes identified in the scope.

573.6(c)(5)

The affected units were built using chassis manufactured by Spartan Chassis and which are affected by their recall 09V-478. The Kongsberg Power Products Systems (KPPS) adjustable brake pedals may loosen. The drive pin which secures the brake pedal arm to the balance assembly may become disengaged, this may cause a reduction in vehicle braking and/or cause the brake pedal to move out of

position and interfere with throttle pedal function. A reduction in braking or interference with the throttle pedal could result in a crash.

573.6(c)(6)

Entegra decided to conduct this recall following notification from Spartan Chassis. Spartan's recall for this matter is 09V-478. Entegra is not aware of any injuries or accidents related to this issue.

573.6(c)(8)

The remedy for the affected motorhomes is replacing the adjustable brake pedal assembly.

Spartan Chassis will be administering this recall on behalf of Entegra Coach. We will provide them with a list of retail owners addresses and they will mail letters to notify each of the owners. Spartan Chassis will also submit quarterly reports to NHTSA on behalf of Entegra Coach.
