1. Vehicles affected are manufactured by:

2. The following vehicles are being recalled:

Certain 2008 through 2010 model year Blue Bird All American, Conventional and Micro-Bird non school buses manufactured from December 16, 2007 through December 21, 2009 equipped with either a Ricon Corporation Model S or K Series Public Use wheelchair lifts.

3. The total number of vehicles recalled potentially containing the noncompliance are:

4. The approximate percentage of the total number of vehicles estimated to actually contain the noncompliance is:

5. The noncompliance consists of:

The restraint belt utilized on the subject lifts was designed to prevent the lift from moving unless the tongue of the belt is fully engaged and latched in the buckle. However, Ricon discovered that it is possible to insert the belt tongue into the buckle without fully engaging the latching mechanism. Should this happen it would appear to be latched and the operator could run the lift with an occupant on the platform. In the event this condition occurs during passenger operations, the wheelchair or mobility aid user could be injured

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6. The following data is the basis for the determination of the noncompliance:

Ricon Corporation notified Blue Bird that it had initiated a recall (NHTSA 09E-060) relating to defect with certain DOT Public Use S & K Series wheelchair lifts.

7. The noncompliance will be corrected in the following manner:

Blue Bird will notify owners to contact their Ricon dealer. Ricon will provide customers with a warning decal and a DVD-based training aid at no cost to owners.

8. Notification will be as follows:

Distributor notification is scheduled to be mailed on or about May 01, 2010.
Owner notification is scheduled to be mailed on or about May 01, 2010.

9. Blue Bird's identification number assigned to this recall is:
