10V-177/10V-178, FL577, Stop Lamps**

Mr. Smith,

In accordance with Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Daimler Trucks North America LLC herewith submits supplemental defect information to amend the expected owner notification date for this recall. In the process of validating the repair procedure DTNA discovered that it was not compatible with all vehicles. DTNA conducted further testing and has developed a repair procedure that is compatible with all vehicles. DTNA will now begin the process of acquiring parts to launch the recall. In the interim, vehicles exhibiting this issue may be able to be remedied by replacing the brake light switch. Replacing the existing brake light switch with another of the same may remedy some vehicles, but it will not remedy all of them.
