Dear Mr. Smith:

Keystone RV Company ("Keystone") has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the recreational vehicles listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Noncompliance Reports.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The recall population includes the following product brands manufactured by Keystone.

The total number of vehicles subject to this recall campaign is: 389

- B. Description of Defect. It has been decided that the remote receiver manufactured by Interactive Technologies, Inc and supplied by River Park, Inc. is not compatible with the high speed landing gear motor. If the motor is operated in a binding situation, the remote receiver may be damaged and overheat due to a combination of inadequate breaker and fuse protection and the excessive amp draw of the motor. Continuing to operate the landing gear motor without the remedy offered will increase the risk of fire, personal injury and property damage.

- C. Basis for Determining that a Defect Exists. Keystone has received 2 complaints of the Interactive Technologies remote receiver igniting resulting in damage to the vehicles. An investigation revealed the motor used with the Interactive Technologies remote system exceeds the design capacity of the remote receiver. The recall population includes all vehicles manufactured with the Interactive Technologies remote system.
- D. Remedying of Defect. The remedy is to be determined.
- E. Owner Notifications. Owner notification will begin June 2010 pending NHTSA approval. A final copy of the dealer repair procedures will also be provided to NHTSA.
- F. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Keystone will be filing quarterly reports in connection with this recall campaign.
- G. Campaign Number. Keystone's identification code for this recall is 10-141.
