Dear Mr. Smith:

Dutchmen Manufacturing ("Dutchmen") has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the recreational vehicles listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Noncompliance Reports.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The recall population includes the following product brands manufactured by Dutchmen.

<u>Product Brand</u>	<u>Number of Vehicles</u>
2009 Freedom Spirit FS250-LE09	71
2009 Freedom Spirit FS250-LE09I	29
The total number of vehicles subject to this recall campaign is: These vehicles were built between 3/12/2009 and 3/25/2009.	100.

- B. Description of Defect. The vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with the incorrect information on the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label. The labels list the wrong tire size. The size should be ST205/75D14 and was listed as ST205/75D15. During replacement of the tires, a consumer could install the incorrect tire potentially leading to property damage.
- C. Basis for Determining that a Defect Exists. The defect was discovered after an inquiry from a dealer and subsequent review of the information listed on the labels. A review of the information stored on file for each vehicle led to the determination of the beginning and ending production range.

- D. Remedying of Defect. The remedy is to replace the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label with the correct one supplied by Dutchmen.
- E. Owner Notifications. Dutchmen will notify the owners of the recreational vehicles by letter beginning on June 14, 2010 pending NHTSA approval. A copy of the owner's letter is attached for approval.
- F. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Dutchmen will be filing quarterly reports in connection with this recall campaign.
- G. Campaign Number. Dutchmen does not have an internal campaign number for this recall. Dutchmen will use the recall campaign number assigned by NHTSA.

The enclosed information should comply with the NHTSA regulations and satisfy the obligations of Dutchmen with respect to this recall campaign.
