This letter is written to notify NHTSA that Fleetwood RV, Inc. is aware of the voluntary initiation of a recall notification campaign affecting Fleetwood produced recreational vehicles as listed below:

This voluntary recall campaign is being conducted by:

This voluntary recall campaign involves approximately 44 Fleetwood Class A motor homes manufactured on a Workhorse Custom Chassis built with a General Motors gasoline engine and a Remy alternator.

Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the above motor homes contain the safety defect. This is based on the Safety Recall notice received on June 7, 2010.

These motor homes were manufactured with a Workhorse Custom Chassis equipped with a Remy alternator. An electrical short in the alternator may occur without warning possibly resulting in a vehicle fire. A vehicle fire may cause property damage, personal injury, or death.

Fleetwood has no reason to disagree with this action or the recall remedy. Fleetwood is relying on Workhorse Custom Chassis and NHTSA to monitor campaign performance.
