## Dear Mr. Smith:

The following information is an amendment to the information in GM's 573 letter dated September 13, 2010 as it relates to a determination by General Motors of a noncompliance involving certain 2009 and 2010 model year Cadillac CTS All Wheel Drive and CTS-V vehicles. This information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6.

GM is amending the letter to provide additional information to sections $573.6(\mathrm{c})(8)$ and 573.6(c)(2)(iv).
573.6(c)(8): Dealers are to replace the glove compartment assembly and, in some vehicles, modify the instrument panel structure (magnesium beam).
GM anticipates sending the dealer bulletin on September 28, 2010 and mailing owner letters starting October 20, 2010 and completing by November 19, 2010.
Pursuant to $577.11(\mathrm{e})$, GM does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.
