Dear Mr. Smith:

Hyundai Motor Company previously submitted a Defect Information Report to NHTSA regarding a recall campaign of certain model year 2011 Sonata vehicles produced beginning December 11, 2009 through September 10, 2010 (NHTSA Recall Number 10V-426) pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Hyundai had estimated in the Part 573 notification that approximately 139,500 vehicles were potentially affected. The affected quantity has been revised to 138,354 vehicles.

Dealers were notified regarding this recall on September 21, 2010. The owner notification letter will be mailed beginning on October 15, 2010. Owner notification will be completed on November 12, 2010, after five weekly mailings.

Enclosed for NHTSA's files are a final copy of the owner notification letter, a final copy of the Technical Service Bulletin and copies of letters to dealers.
