These vehicles were manufactured by Newmar Corporation between August 16, 2001 and June 02, 2010.

Comprehensive Vehicle Population.

The total number of vehicles included in this campaign is 435.

Effected Population Assessment.

100% of the vehicle models identified above and equipped with a Dimplex brand electric fireplace may contain the affected equipment.

Defect Description.

Dimplex has received reports of plug-in remote control units overheating, including reports of damage. Specific recreation vehicles manufactured by Newmar Corporation, as identified above, were equipped with the defective plug-in remote control receiver.

Principle Event Chronology.

Newmar Corporation was notified of the equipment recall campaign being conducted by Dimplex North America having campaign identification number 10E-027, on August 13, 2010.

Newmar Corporation is not aware of any property damage, injury, or death, in vehicles manufactured by Newmar, attributed directly or indirectly to this defect.

Defect Remedy Program.

Dimplex will provide replacement plug-in remote control receivers without charge. Owners of vehicles affected by this recall campaign will be advised to contact Dimplex North America in order to make arrangements to have the remedy completed by Dimplex, as set forth in equipment recall campaign 10E-027 being conducted by Dimplex North America.

Consumer notification will commence following approval of notification documents. Draft documents will be submitted for review.
