Re: Recall 10V-436; Supplement to Isuzu's Part 573 Report

Dear Ms. Timian:

I am writing to supplement the information provided in the Part 573 Report submitted by Isuzu Manufacturing Services of America, Inc. ("Isuzu"), on September 22, 2010, with respect to excessive corrosion affecting rear suspension lower link brackets in certain MY 1998-2002 Isuzu Rodeo and Honda Passport vehicles and MY 2002 Isuzu Axiom vehicles.

The number of subject vehicles covered by this recall (i.e., MY 1998-2002 Isuzu Rodeos and MY 2002 Isuzu Axioms initially registered in or currently registered in 21 identified states plus the District of Columbia, and MY1998-2002 Honda Passports initially sold in or currently registered in those states) is as follows:

We will send you an additional supplement early next week with the VIN range and manufacturing date range of the vehicles covered by this recall.

Isuzu intends to conduct this recall in accordance with the following schedule. Owners of subject vehicles covered by the recall will be notified of the defect in early December 2010. Isuzu service facilities will be notified approximately one week prior to the beginning of the owner notification campaign. (We expect that Honda will notify its dealers at approximately the same time.) Isuzu will provide your office with proposed owner notification letters for your review in the near future.
