Dear Sir or Madam:

On August 13, 2010 Carriage Incorporated (“The Company” or “Carriage”) was notified by Wesco International, Inc. of a potential defect which relates to motor vehicle safety in vehicles Carriage Incorporated manufactured with certain plug-in remote control receivers for fireplaces supplied by Dimplex North America, Ltd. In accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Noncompliance Reports, Carriage is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

#### Identification of Vehicles in Campaign

The vehicles covered by this report are recreational vehicles that were equipped with certain plug-in remote control receivers for fireplaces manufactured by Dimplex North America, Ltd. between 2002 through 2010.

Cameo	2002 – 2010
Compass	2005 – 2006
Carriage	2004
Royals	2004

The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records for the Company’s manufacturing plants in Millersburg, Indiana that produced the affected fifth wheel trailers. More specifically, the scope has been derived by identification of units equipped with the specific models of fireplaces that used the plug-in remote control receivers during the stated model years.

#### Campaign Population

The total number of vehicles covered by this Report is 394 (three hundred ninety-four).

## Defect Estimate

Based on information received from Wesco, Carriage believes that approximately 100 percent of these vehicles actually contain the defect.

## Description of Defect

In some instances, the plug-in remote control receiver, which is a component of a factory installed fireplace, can overheat, posing a fire hazard.

## Chronology of Events


Carriage learned of this defect through notification from Wesco International, Inc. Carriage is not aware of any injuries or other incidents as a result of this condition.

## Remedy Program

Dimplex has arranged to conduct a recall to remedy the potential defect in Carriage vehicles at no charge to vehicle owners. See Recall No. 10E-027. Pursuant to 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8)(i) and 573.13, owners will be advised that Dimplex will reimburse them if they have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for a plug-in remote control receiver containing such a defect prior to their receipt of the notification.
