Kawasaki Motors Corp., U.S.A. ("KMC") hereby provides additional information needed to fully comply with the reporting requirements of 49CFR 573.5 (c). This correspondence supplements the previous Defect Report dated October 14, 2010.

- 2) Identification of the affected units potentially containing the defect: This recall affects the 2009 and 2010 Kawasaki Vulcan® 1700 Voyager®, Nomad™ and Classic. The beginning and ending manufacturing dates are January 9, 2009 to February 26, 2010.
- 3) The total number of vehicles potentially containing the defect: 6,187
- 9) A representative copy of all notices, bulletins and other communications that relate directly to the defect or noncompliance: A copy of the first issued service bulletin and customer letter are attached. The service bulletin will be mailed to dealers on Friday October 29, 2010 and the customer letter will begin mailing on Monday, November 1, 2010 .
