Safety Recall No. 5 – Parking Brake Lever

Global Electric Motorcars, LLC (GEM) has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain GEM vehicles.

Models: Most VINs (last six) from 050597 through 050739.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification until the defect is remedied.

Subject: The parking brake cable may have been improperly crimped. This could cause the parking brake cable to separate from the vehicle. If this happens, your parked vehicle could roll away on a hill, creating a risk of crash or injury.

Remedy: The parking brake assembly on all affected vehicles will be replaced by with a new parking brake assembly.

Owner Notification and Service Scheduling: All involved vehicle owners known to GEM have been notified of the safety defect. They are requested to call (866) 764-0616 to identify an approved service provider and to schedule an appointment. A generic copy of the owner letter is attached.

Parts Information: Parts to complete this recall repair are currently available through the regular GEM parts system.

Service Procedure: See attached Service Bulletin - "Parking Brake Assembly Replacement".

Completion Reporting and Reimbursement: Claims for vehicles that have been serviced must be submitted on the GEMconnect warranty system. Claims submitted will be used by GEM to record recall service completions and provide dealer payments.

Use the following labor operation numbers and time allowances:

Add the cost of the recall parts package plus applicable dealer allowance to your claim.

NOTE: See the Warranty Administration Manual for complete recall claim processing instructions.

Vehicle Lists, Global Recall System, VIP and Dealer Follow Up: All involved vehicles have been entered into the GEMconnect Global Data Base System. Dealers can call the GEM Customer Service group at (866) 764-0616 to inquire about a specific VIN.

Recall VIN lists may contain confidential, restricted owner name and address information that was obtained from the Department of Motor Vehicles of various states. Use of this information is permitted for this recall only and is strictly prohibited from all other use.
