Dear Skyline Dealer:

On May 3, 2010, Skyline contacted the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to report a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety in its 2004 through 2007 Park Model trailers manufactured between June 1, 2003 and May 31, 2007.

Specifically, certain 2004 through 2007 model year park model trailer recreational vehicles may have been equipped with a defective remote control receiver. In some instances, the plug-in remote control receiver can overheat, posing a fire hazard. Dimplex, the manufacturer of the component, has received about 5,000 reports of the plug-in wall units overheating. Skyline purchased 44 units from this supplier. However we cannot determine if a vehicle is affected without inspecting the park model trailers.

Skyline will contact all customers who purchased one of these recreational vehicles. Our records show that you received the following units. The following units remain in your stock. Please inspect the remote control receivers of each and document the model number and date code on this sheet. Please return the completed sheet to Skyline via fax at 1-574-522-5257 or by US Postal service to the attention of Ronald Foster, Skyline Corporation, P.O. Box 743, Elkhart, IN 46515. We will send a replacement receiver for each affected receiver identified.
