Dear Sir: **SAFETY RECALL NOTICE**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Wilson Trailer Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain Wilson spread tandem livestock trailers manufactured with Neway RL, RLU and CB-2300 suspensions built from March 1, 2000 to August 1, 2008.

The defect concerns the cross channel between the front and rear suspension hangers. The cross channel can break and, if undetected, over time can cause the frame to flex causing severe cracking of the frame. This could lead to a loss of suspension and increase a risk of a crash.

To remedy this defect, please contact your Wilson dealer or authorized repair facility so they can inspect the area of concern, replace the existing channel with a new style and repair any existing cracks of the frame. The inspection, repair, and installation will be provided to you at no cost.

If you have any questions regarding this notice, please contact your Wilson dealer or Todd Heitman at Wilson Trailer Company or if you do not presently own the above listed trailer please contact Linda Kollbaum at Wilson Trailer Company at 1-800-798-2002.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lesser receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of the notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Wilson Trailer Company, Todd Heitman at 1-800-798-2002.

We regret any inconvenience that this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety. Dear Sir:

Wilson Trailer Company has decided that a possible defect exists in certain Wilson spread tandem livestock trailers manufactured with Neway RL, RLU and CB-2300 suspensions built between March 1, 2000 to August 1, 2008. The defect concerns the cross channel between the front and rear suspension hangers. The cross channel can break and, if undetected, over time can cause the frame to flex causing severe cracking of the frame. This could lead to a loss of suspension and increase the risk of a crash.

Your company has sold some of these trailers. Enclosed is a listing of your customers and serial numbers for the affected trailers. Wilson Trailer Company has notified these customers per the enclosed Safety Recall Notice. They have been given the option to contact you if they have questions. If contacted, please answer these questions.

Review the list of customer to confirm that they still own the serial number trailer on your list. If any of your customers have sold or traded the affected trailers, please advise Linda Kollbaum of the new owner and address if available.

Wilson Trailer Company has determined that it is necessary to inspect the areas of concern for broken or missing suspension cross channels and cracking of the frame around the hangers. All cross channels will be replaced with a new style channel. If the frame is cracked, photos will need to be emailed to warranty@wilsontrailer.com for engineering evaluation and the proper repair for the cracking of the frame. Repair invoices will be sent to my attention at Wilson Trailer Company. The description on the invoice should read "526D REPLACE THE CHANNELS BETWEEN THE HANGERS WITH THE NEW STYLE". To replace both front and rear cross channels with the new style will take between 5 to 7 man hours.

In the event you have any of the affected trailers on your lot, you will need to inspect and take action outlined above. I will need to be notified of any such trailers on your lot.
