This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

GEM has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your GEM vehicle.

The problem is: The parking brake cable may have been improperly crimped. This could cause the parking brake cable to separate from the vehicle. If this happens, your parked vehicle could roll away on a hill, creating a risk of crash or injury.

What GEM will do: GEM will repair your vehicle free of charge (parts and labor). The work will take approximately one hour.

What you must do: Simply contact Global Electric Motorcars to schedule a service appointment. The number to call is (866) 764-0616.
