

## **SAFETY RECALL – TRAILER BRAKE SYSTEM**

Dear Metal Fabrication Boat Trailer Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

### **REASON FOR THE RECALL**

Metal Fabrication has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2010 boat trailers equipped with brake systems manufactured between August 1, 2009 and January 26, 2010. The defect relates to an improperly assembled brake actuator and air in the brake lines. This could result in the brake system not engaging when operated and the subsequent loss of braking ability of your trailer.

### **WHAT WE WILL DO**

To correct this condition, your dealer will inspect and test the brake system. If the brake system functions properly, no further action will be required. If there are any leaks in the system or if air is present in the brake lines, then your dealer will repair the leaks and bleed the air out of the brake lines. The brake system will be retested to insure that it is functioning properly. This service will be done at no charge to you. Instructions for making this correction have been sent to your dealer and parts are available.

### **WHAT YOU SHOULD DO**

Please contact your dealer as soon as possible to arrange a service date so the dealer may inspect your trailer. The labor time to perform this inspection and correction if necessary is approximately 30 minutes. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your trailer.

If you have any problem obtaining the needed service, please call Metal Fabrication Customer Service at (931) 962-0025. A customer service representative will assist you to arrange prompt attention for your trailer.

The enclosed Owner Reply Card identifies your trailer. Presentation of this card to your dealer will assist in making the necessary correction in the shortest possible time. If you have sold or traded your trailer, please let us know by completing the reply card and returning it to us.

We are sorry to cause this inconvenience; however, we have taken this action in the interest of your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

If your dealer fails or is unable to remedy this defect without charge and within a reasonable time, you may submit a written complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Ave SE, Washington, DC 20590.
