Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that certain Medium Duty vehicles built between February 16, 2010 and March 24, 2010, with hydraulic brakes, fail to comply with requirements of FMVSS No. 105, "Hydraulic and Electric Brake Systems". Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period.

Affected vehicles have an incorrectly designed ABS system wire harness. The design flaw may cause the ABS malfunction indicator lamp not to illuminate when there is an issue with the ABS system. Peterbilt is recalling these vehicles to repair the wire harness, verify that proper components are installed and set vehicle computer parameters to ensure proper operation of the ABS system malfunction indicator lamp.

<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Repair wire; verify ABS system operation
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to repair the wire harness and replace parts. Please contact your authorized Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment. The service should take no more than 1.5 hours and will be provided at no charge to you.

If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.
