**IMPORTANT: Safety Notice**

**SAFETY – RECALL – 10V-209**

Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Motors Chassis, Inc. has decided a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain fire truck cab/chassis equipped with Electronic Stability Control (ESC).

*Please note: The Vehicle Identification Number that may be affected by this recall is located at the top of this letter.*

**Defect or Noncompliance:**

In certain cases, the ESC system may inadvertently interpret vehicle instability, even though the vehicle may be stable, which would require intervention of brake activation to a selected wheel as a result of electromagnetic interference simulating a false yaw event.

Inadvertent brake application to a selected wheel may cause the driver to try and over correct possibly resulting in a vehicle crash.

**Corrective Action:**

The transmission cable is connected to the power source located on the curb side of the vehicle. Detach said cable from the right side of the vehicle, reroute to street side power source and reattach to appropriate power source. (Reference RSB10-810-001)

**Labor Time:**

The labor time allotted to perform said repairs will be one (1) hour. Due to some service scheduling times, your service center may need your vehicle for a longer period.

**What You Should Do:**

Call Spartan Chassis at 800-543-5008 (Option 5) with your current mileage. It will then be determined if your unit is part of the recall. If so, steps will be taken to ensure the recall is performed at the nearest authorized service center. You do not need to call Spartan Chassis to find the facility most convenient to you. These facilities can be located on Spartan's website: <http://www.spartanchassis.com>. If you lack access to the internet, call 800-543-5008 (Option 1) for locations.

**Leased Vehicles:**

The lesser must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

**Reimbursement:**

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan Chassis at 800-543-5008 (Option 6).

**Reply Card:**

Please fill out the enclosed prepaid postcard and mail it to us if you have changed your address, sold, or traded the vehicle.

If the authorized service center has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge and within a reasonable time, contact Spartan Chassis at 800-543-4277 - Option 1.
