Dear Mr. Retail Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

EZ Loader Adjustable Boat Trailers, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2010 EZ Loader trailer models.

This defect involves the axle installed on the trailer. This defect creates the potential for the spindle to separate from the axle causing the tire and wheel to separate from the trailer while underway. This occurrence could result in a crash without prior warning.

Due to the possibility of this condition existing on your trailer, we are recommending that the trailer not be operated for any reason until repairs can be made.

The repair involves replacing the axle assembly.

EZ Loader will provide for the inspection and repairs at no cost to you. If necessary, EZ will pay for or reimburse you for the cost of transporting your trailer to an authorized repair facility.

These repairs may be made in one of two ways. First, EZ Loader will have repair teams in areas where concentrations of these trailers are located. In this situation, EZ Loader personnel will come to where your trailer is located and make the repairs at that location. Alternately, you may have your trailer transported to your EZ Loader dealer or another repair facility capable of performing the necessary work to have these repairs made. In either case, EZ Loader will pay the cost of the repair to the trailer and the transportation cost.

If it is necessary for you to have your trailer transported to a repair facility, advise the tow operator to use a "dolly" or a flat bed transport. Under no circumstances should the trailer be towed behind a vehicle with the trailer's wheels bearing the load of the trailer on the road.
