## SAFETY RECALL G-10507

**JUNE 2010**

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain CE and RE model buses built 2/22/10 thru 3/16/10 with passenger flip seat feature code 48UAH or 48UAU.

### ***REASON FOR THIS RECALL***

The weld that retains the reinforcement rod inside the flip seat back frame tube may fail allowing the rod to fall out of the frame.

### ***RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY***

Without the reinforcement rod the strength of the seat may be reduced possibly increasing the risk of property damage, personal injury, or death in the event of a crash.

### ***ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE***

IC Bus' records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

**If you own this vehicle**, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com>. The repair will involve the inspection of the reinforcement rod retaining weld and, if necessary, replacement of the seat frame. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and may take 2 hours to complete.

**If you are the lessor of this vehicle**, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

**If you do not own this vehicle**, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

### ***IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE***

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
