SAFETY RECALL G-10508

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain CE model buses built 1/19/10 thru 1/21/10 with a MaxxFlex DT engine.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The high pressure power steering hose may be rubbing on the power steering reservoir mounting bracket possibly resulting in a power steering fluid leak in the engine compartment.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

A power steering fluid leak in the engine compartment may cause a fire resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

IC Bus' records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com>. The repair will involve the inspection and, if necessary, the correction of the power steering hose routing. Dealers have instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and may take 60 minutes to complete.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
