Dear Sir or Madam,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Bad Boy Enterprises has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your Classic LSV Buggy.

If the accelerator pedal assembly in your buggy becomes damaged due to exposure to water, the pedal may send an electrical signal and voltage to the electric motor, causing it to accelerate when the driver has not requested acceleration through activating the pedal. Unwanted acceleration may result in a loss of control of the buggy and a crash.

Bad Boy Enterprises will replace the accelerator pedal on your buggy free of charge. Please contact your Bad Boy Buggy dealer to make arrangements for the recall work. We estimate that the recall work will take 90 minutes to perform; however, individual appointments will vary depending on the workload at the dealership.

If you believe that Bad Boy Enterprises has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge within a reasonable time, please contact us at 1-866-678-6701.
