IMPORTANT RECALL NOTICE

June 14, 2010

Dear Volvo Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Volvo Cars of North America, LLC (Volvo) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain model year 2010 S40 and V50 vehicles and certain model year 2010 & 2011 C30 vehicles equipped with Manual 6-Speed Transmissions.

The reason for Recall 227:

Volvo has identified that the gearshift lever stud assembly may not have been tightened to the correct specification during assembly. If the gearshift lever cable or stud assembly becomes loose, it may not be possible to engage, disengage or shift gears. This condition can increase the risk of a vehicle crash.

The corrective action is to torque the gearshift lever stud assembly to the correct specification.

What you need to do:

Please contact your authorized Volvo retailer to schedule an appointment. This procedure will be completed at no cost and can take 30 minutes to complete; however, due to service scheduling and parts availability, the time your Volvo retailer requires to service your vehicle may vary.

If you previously paid to have this corrective action performed, prior to the date on this letter, your authorized Volvo retailer will honor your receipt with a refund. Please contact your authorized Volvo retailer service department for details.
