SAFETY RECALL G-10511

Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 4300M, 8600, LoneStar, and ProStar model trucks built 5/6/09 thru 5/25/10 with steering gear feature codes 05PRP or 05PRR.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The fastener that clamps the pitman arm to the steering gear shaft may not have been fully tightened upon assembly. This condition may allow the pitman arm to slip on the shaft resulting in reduction of steering control.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Reduction in steering control increases the risk of a crash that may result in property damage, personal injury, or death.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve the inspection of the pitman arm – steering gear shaft joint, and, if necessary, the tightening of the pitman arm fastener or replacement of the pitman arm. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 60 minutes to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Navistar's records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any INTERNATIONAL® dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.internationaltrucks.com>.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.
