Dear Valued Skyline Recreational Vehicle Customer:

SAFETY RECALL TO REPLACE 15" XINGMIN WHEELS

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Skyline Corporation, on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing facilities, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain recreational vehicles as described below.

15" x 6" welded wheels manufactured by Xingmin Wheel ("Xingmin") bearing the rim stamp "07 10 06Z" or "08 10 16B" on the back-side of the wheel, in the rim. The subject wheels include the following part numbers:

Part numbers: TF15X6655SS (silver spoke)
TF15X6655WM (white mod)
TF15X6655MS (silver mod)
TF15X6545WMS (white mod with stripe)
TF15X6655WS (white spoke with and without stripe)

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Specifically, certain 2011 recreational vehicles may have been equipped with defective wheels. There is poor weld quality in the rim of the wheels. The poor weld may cause the center of the wheel to separate from the rim.

SEPARATION OF THE WHEEL FROM THE RIM MAY RESULT IN A LOSS OF CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE. THIS CONDITION MAY CAUSE A CRASH AND/OR INJURY WITHOUT WARNING.

WHAT SKYLINE CORPORATION WILL DO

Skyline will provide at no charge to the customer:

- Visual inspection of the wheels.
- Replacement of affected wheels.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Since this defect affects motor vehicle safety, it is recommended that you immediately make an appointment with your selling dealer or other authorized Skyline dealer to have your vehicle inspected.

At the time of your appointment the dealer will perform the required inspection and make any necessary repair. The total length of time your vehicle will be out of service will depend on the dealer's work schedule at the time of the repairs.

If you have had this concern corrected previously, you may be eligible for reimbursement of your cost for the repair. For more information regarding this recall contact (800) 733-4250.

When you deliver your travel trailer for repairs, your dealer will complete a Skyline Repair Order. Upon completion of the inspection, and if necessary the subsequent repair, please sign the Skyline Repair Order.

If You No Longer Own This Recreational Vehicle:

If you have changed your address or sold the travel trailer, please take a moment to provide the name and address of the person or dealership you sold it to on the enclosed Vehicle Information Update Card, and return it to Skyline. That way we can update our records, and notify the new owner using the information you provide.

Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you are unable to obtain the specified inspection and/or repair promptly and without charge, please contact **Skyline Consumer Relations at (800) 733-4250**.
