**Re: Defect Information Report – Supplemental Report No. 3
10V-339, 10C-4, DD15 Bosch HP Fuel Pump**

Mr. Smith,

In accordance with Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Daimler Trucks North America LLC herewith submits supplemental defect information to amend the expected owner notification date for this recall. DTNA forwarded owner notification letters to its mailing service and released this campaign to its dealer body on Monday March 14. Shortly after this release DTNA was notified by its supplier that a batch of parts prepared for this action did not meet the supplier's quality standards. Upon receiving this notification DTNA suspended this campaign, and retrieved the owner's notification letters from the postal service. DTNA is currently in the process of sorting, inspecting, and repackaging the parts needed for this recall. DTNA expects to have 25% of the kits needed to re-release this campaign by Monday March 21, and will begin shipping parts to dealers at that time.

Due to problems with parts availability, DTNA will re-launch this campaign in phases. During the week of March 28th, 30% of affected owners will be notified to bring their vehicles in for the remedy. The remaining owners will receive interim notification letters the week of March 21st, and receive a final notification letter as parts become available.
